Both girls suffer from underlying conditions. Zaylee was born with epilepsy and Chloe has a heart defect. They have been active from a very young age. Zaylee loves gymnastics and Chloe plays soccer. With the sales from their business, they are proud to "give back" and donate to the Children's Heart, Epilepsy and Cancer foundations.

When asked "what inspires you to do what you do?", they responded, "We both have health issues, but we don't want it to define us. We hope to inspire people to not let anything stop them from doing what they love."

Credit Card Fraud Alert

We're Your Financial Safety Partner

Although credit card fraud is a fact of modern life, it is important that you know **your funds are safe at Gather FCU**. Here are a few tips to help stop credit card fraud:

- Don't give your card number over the phone, unless you initiated the call.
- Carry cards separately from your wallet or carry one card at a time.
- Keep an eye on your credit card statements. If any transactions look suspicious, notify your institution immediately.
- Alert the institution if you change your address or will be traveling.
- Don't write your card number on something that could end up in the trash.


