Rooted Over 50 Years

As Gather celebrates its 70th anniversary, we love reflecting on members who have been a part of this incredible journey, such as Gary and Haunani Pacheco. They are proud credit union supporters whose deep connection to their community and Gather represents the heart of our mission.

Gary was born in Lihue and raised in Kīlauea. Haunani was born in Honolulu and raised in Hanalei, where they met in 1965. They recently celebrated their 54th wedding anniversary, a testament to their enduring love and partnership. They have two sons and two grandchildren, and their commitment to our shared home runs just as deep as their family bonds.

The Pachecos have long been involved in giving back to their Kīlauea community. Along with Mr. Pacheco's involvement with Kaulana Kīlauea, the Kilauea Point Natural History Assn., and the North Shore Lions Club, he and his wife keep busy with their business flower farm in Kalihiwai Ridge. Their strong community ties and thriving business keep them "connected to their roots."

Mr. Pacheco's relationship with Gather began in 1964, when he opened his first account to purchase a stereo for his parents. Katherine McNelly, who worked at the credit union, opened his account with just \$20 and helped him secure his first loan in a matter of minutes. He nicknamed the credit union "the umbrella man"—always there when needed, rain or shine.

Mr. Pacheco has witnessed Gather's growth over the years, from serving the sugar plantation workers in the early '60s in a little office space just on the left of the entrance of the Dispensary Stone Building in Kīlauea town—to becoming a cornerstone of the community. Both he and his wife look forward to the convenience of the new Kīlauea branch opening soon, bringing the "personal connection" to their town where they can always see someone in person.

Gather is honored to have members like the Pachecos, whose values and vision are at the core of who we are. As we continue to grow together for the next 70 years, we look forward to serving the Pachecos and community members just like them.

As we talk about financial security this holiday season, remember some tips for making payments with Zelle. While Zelle is a convenient way to send and receive money, it's crucial to remember it's only safe when used with people you trust. Once you authorize a payment, there's no fraud protection for unauthorized transactions.

If you're unsure about using Zelle to pay someone you don't know, it's best to avoid it, particularly for high-risk transactions, such as online purchases from unfamiliar sellers. Zelle doesn't offer purchase protection, so if something goes wrong, you may not get your money back.

- Zelle is a feature on the Gather Mobile app.
- The daily spending limit for Zelle is \$500. Stay safe this holiday season!
